1. MEET OVERVIEW

The Inter Polytechnic Sports and Games Meet (IPSGM) 2023–24 is an annual flagship sporting event organised by the Department of Technical Education, Government of Andhra Pradesh. The meet operates at three progressive levels — Institutional, Regional, and State — providing polytechnic students across Andhra Pradesh a competitive platform in athletics and team games.

The Kadapa Regional Level Boys meet was hosted by Government Polytechnic, Rajampeta from 06 December 2023 to 08 December 2023. The event drew participation from over 30 government and private polytechnics and engineering colleges of the Kadapa (YSR) district and surrounding region.

11. RULES & GUIDELINES

11.1 General Rules

- All competitors must bring their own necessary equipment.
- In Athletics, each participant is eligible to take part in 2 track and 2 field events (or vice-versa).
- All colleges must submit game-wise eligibility performance data.
- Participating colleges bear their own travelling expenses.
- Accommodation is provided at the host institution's hostel for outstation participants.
- Participants must carry identity cards, bed sheets, pillows, towels, uniform, and water bottles.
- Participants are responsible for their own belongings. The host institution bears no liability.
- All participants must maintain discipline and good conduct throughout the event.
- Any misbehaviour, indisciplinary conduct, or anti-social activity results in immediate disqualification and a 3-year ban from IPSGM.
- Identity cards must be produced before the verification committee and before each match/event.

11.2 Registration Requirements

- Submit deputation orders from the concerned Principal.
- Submit Bonafide certificates and Indemnity bonds for all participants.
- Pay registration fee of ₹400 per participant.
- Collect food tokens and Identity Cards (IPSGM) from the registration desk.
- Submit a printout of enrolled participants from the portal: <https://ipsgmteap.com/>
- All Physical Directors must attend the drawing of fixtures at 10:30 AM on Day 1.

11.3 Qualification Criteria

Regional level winners' team in games and 1st and 2nd place holders in sports events are eligible to participate in the State Level IPSGM in their respective games and sports. All decisions of referees and umpires are final and shall not be challenged.

12.4. Results and Standings

While individual excellence was celebrated, the following institutions dominated the medals tally:

- 🏆 GAMES OVERALL CHAMPIONS: It's a tie! Loyola Polytechnic (Pulivendula) and Govt. Polytechnic (Proddatur) share the top spot with 13 points each.
- SPORTS OVERALL CHAMPION: Govt. Polytechnic - Proddatur (022) is the clear winner dominant across track and field events with 36 points.

13. KEY OBSERVATIONS & STATISTICAL HIGHLIGHTS

KEY FINDINGS	
★	Loyola Polytechnic (Code 029) fielded the largest documented contingent with 51 boys (36 games + 15 sports) and 25 girls (14 games + 11 sports).
★	Kabaddi and Volleyball emerged as the most popular team games, each drawing 12 players from Loyola alone.
★	Ball Badminton, a traditional Indian game, saw strong participation with 7 players from Loyola and 4 from Simhadripuram.
★	GPT Simhadripuram (Code 184) fielded 34 boys total — 19 in games and 15 in athletics — showing a 50-50 split between team games and athletics.
★	Loyola's Athletics contingent showed strength in Throws (J. Jaswanth Reddy in Shot Put, Discuss & Javelin) and Relay events (100x4 and 400x4 with dedicated squads).
★	Third-year students (III-DECE, III-DEEE, III-DCME) dominated participation from Loyola, reflecting greater awareness and motivation among senior students.
★	14 Physical Education Teachers from ZPHS schools across Annamayya District were formally deputed as referees and officials, ensuring professional management.
★	Over 26 institutions from YSR Kadapa region are documented in the user/registration system, indicating broad regional representation.
★	First-year students (I-DECE, I-DCME) also showed meaningful participation, suggesting early sports culture integration in polytechnic education.

14. RECOMMENDATIONS

1. Digitise all entry forms for seamless data management and faster verification at the venue.
2. Introduce girls' volleyball and kabaddi at the regional level to match the boys' programme breadth.
3. Encourage first and second-year students through institutional-level selections earlier in the semester.
4. Standardise the entry portal (<https://ipsgmteap.com/>) across all institutions and ensure credential distribution well before the event date.
5. Maintain a central database of missing passwords / user credentials (as evidenced by the KADAPA_MISSING_PASS_WORDS.xlsx) and resolve these at least 4 weeks before the meet.
6. Increase the number of deputed Physical Directors proportional to the number of events and colleges to improve officiating quality.
7. Provide official certificates and mementos digitally in addition to physical copies for better record-keeping.

15. CONCLUSION

The Inter Polytechnic Sports and Games Meet 2023–24 at Kadapa Regional Level was a well-organised, multi-day sporting event that successfully brought together students from over 30 institutions across the YSR Kadapa region. Government Polytechnic, Rajampeta served as an exemplary host, constituting comprehensive committees and coordinating with the District Educational Officer for official deputation of Physical Education Teachers.

Loyola Polytechnic (YSRR) and GPT Proddutur demonstrated strong institutional commitment to sports by fielding large, diverse contingents across both track & field athletics and a wide array of team games. The event upheld the Department of Technical Education's vision of producing not just technically proficient graduates but well-rounded, disciplined, and physically fit future professionals.

Regional winners in all events are eligible to advance to the State Level IPSGM, further motivating students to excel at the institutional and regional stages. With continued administrative support and improved digital processes, the IPSGM has the potential to become a premier inter-polytechnic sporting championship in Andhra Pradesh.
